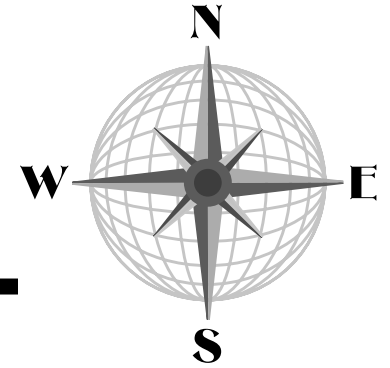


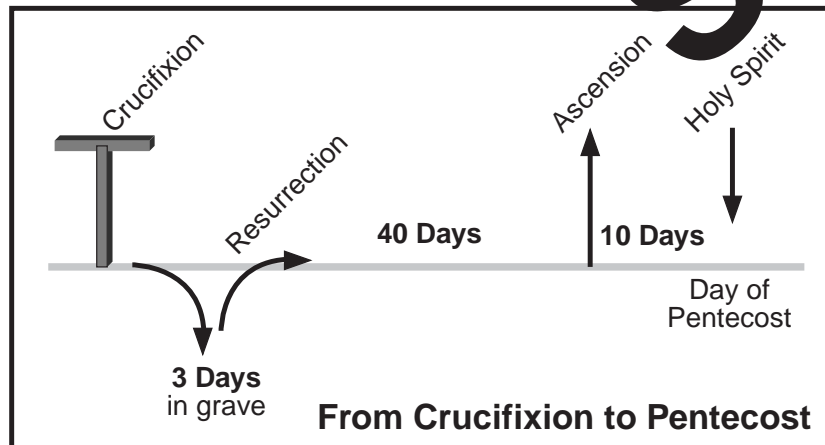

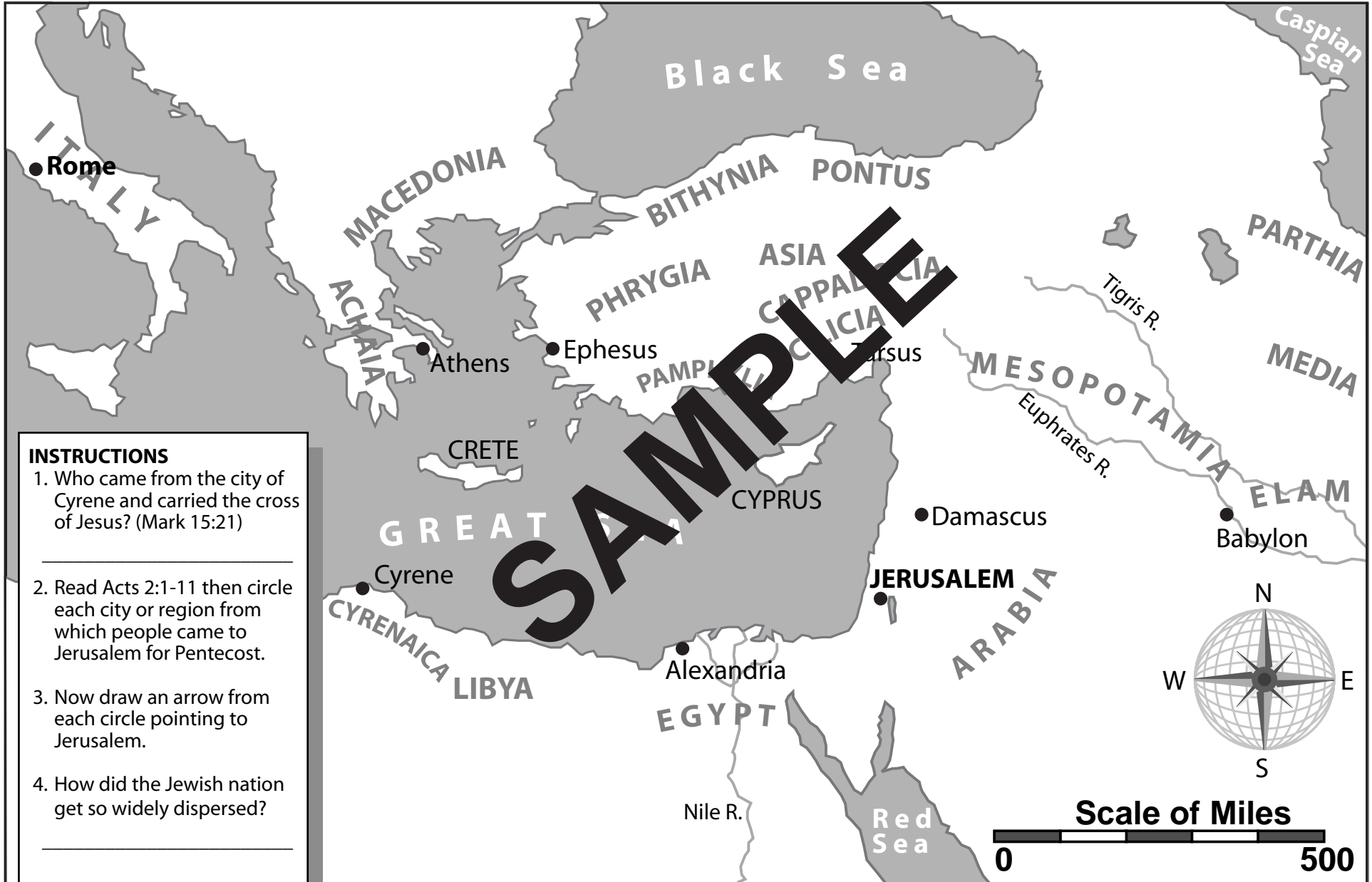

THE DAY OF PENTECOST



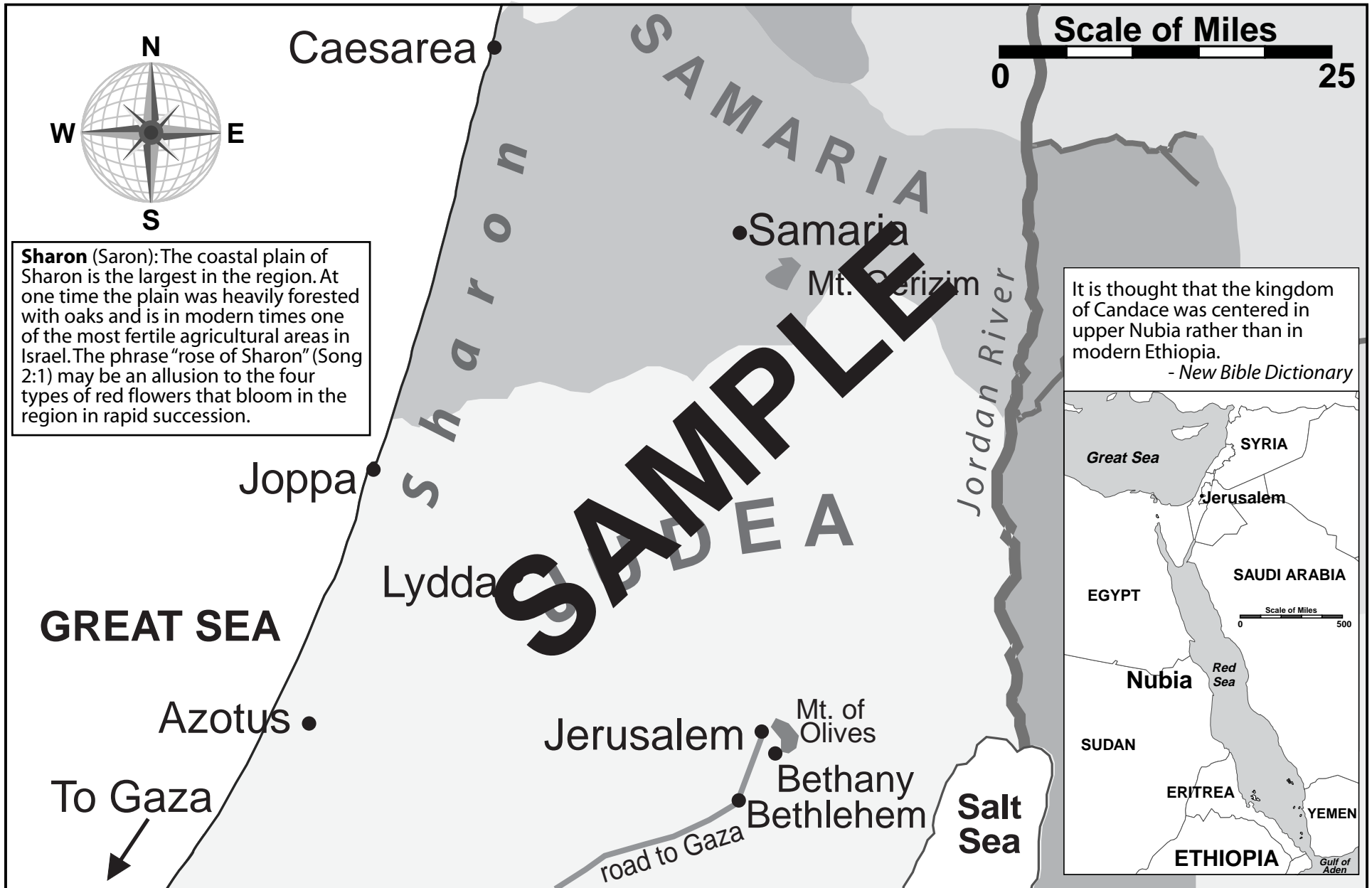
INSTRUCTIONS

QUESTION: Of those listed as being in Jerusalem for Pentecost, who travelled the furthest to be present? _____ About how far did they travel? _____ miles

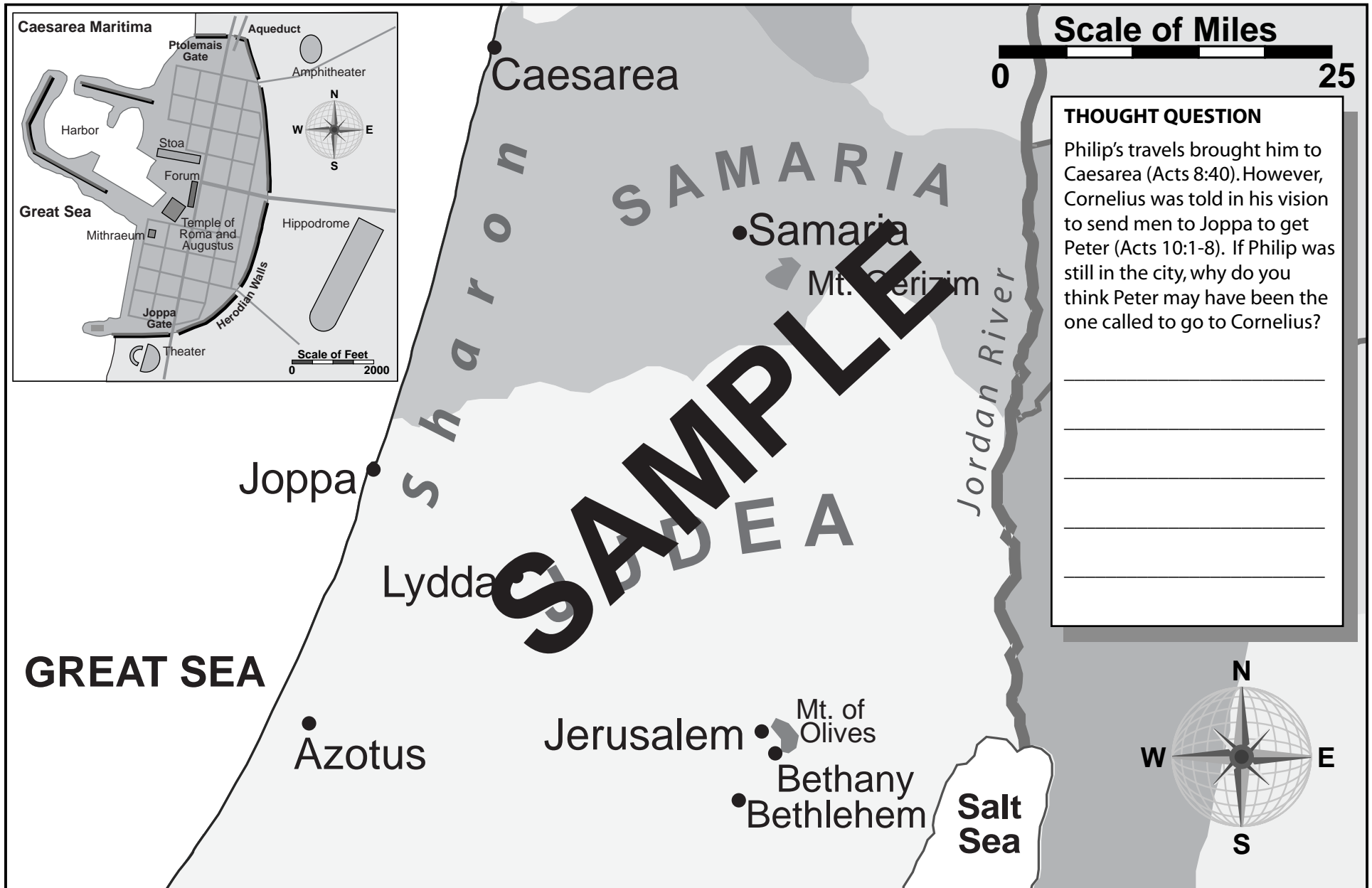
THE EARLY CHURCH – TRAVELS OF PHILIP
